

Call for Proposals

The **Fifth Annual Northeast Ohio Transition Symposium** will be taking place on **December 4, 2019** at **Kent State University**. The goal of the symposium is to provide an opportunity for educators to share innovative practices and programs to support positive secondary outcomes for ALL students. Average attendance at this is 350-400 participants so this is an opportunity to spotlight effective practices occurring in your district.




You are invited to submit a proposal to share best practices, expertise, and knowledge with other educators working to promote and improve practices for Transition and College and Career Readiness for ALL students. Presenters will have a 45 minute session to share their work with audiences [Internet access and a projector will be provided]. Accuracy and completeness in filling out the electronic form will assist the Planning Committee in giving full consideration to your [proposal](#).

Proposals must be submitted by September 15, 2019.

Guidelines:

1. Presenters must be able to share how their work impacted or improved student outcomes and/or the Transition Planning process for students.
2. Proposals must address the “learning outcomes” for the audience and what they will be able to do or share with their district/building teams as a result of attending your session.
3. Provide a presentation title as you would like it to appear in the conference planner or program. Please be sure to avoid abbreviations and acronyms that may be unclear.
- 4.. Provide a clear description of your presentation as you would like it to appear in the conference planner or program; descriptions will be limited to 150 words. Be sure the description includes what to expect from the session and encourages participation in the learning opportunity.
5. Proposals must indicate which (areas) of the Transition Taxonomy (see graphic below and/or attached document) are reflected in the work the presenter will be sharing with their audience.

Timeline for Proposals:

1. Completed proposals are due **September 15, 2019**.
2. All proposal contacts will receive an email notifying them of their acceptance, along with specific information on the next steps no later than September 27, 2019.
